



1st Call: overview



- 23 projects were submitted
- Large variety of topics: tourism, ports, regeneration, environment, culture and heritage, public service, social inclusion
- Priority 1 = 13 projects
- Priority 2 = 3 projects
- Priority 3 = 7 projects
- 13 projects with a UK Lead Partner
- Largest partnership: 30 !
- Highest ERDF request: 8 600 000€



Strengths of the 1st Call





- Balance between maritime and nonmaritime projects
- Quality of partnership in general
- Majority of the projects is well written
- No real pattern regarding allocation of funds per budget line



Weaknesses of the 1st Call





- Level of cross border cooperation not sufficient (shopping lists)
- Lot of follow-on projects from IIIA FR-UK
- Lack of totally new partnerships comparing to Interreg IIIA although many projects expanding towards B & NL
- Lack of innovation
- Lack of focus: some projects would have been stronger with some costs left out
- High budgets = difficulties to justify Value for Money
- In some cases, lack of additionality



Key messages



- Explain your project
- Do not try to do everything: focus
 - Cross border partnership is not enough: ideas & activities must be cross border too
 - If the partnership/budget/activities are
 - unbalanced: explain why
- Just follow-on is not enough
- aditionality
